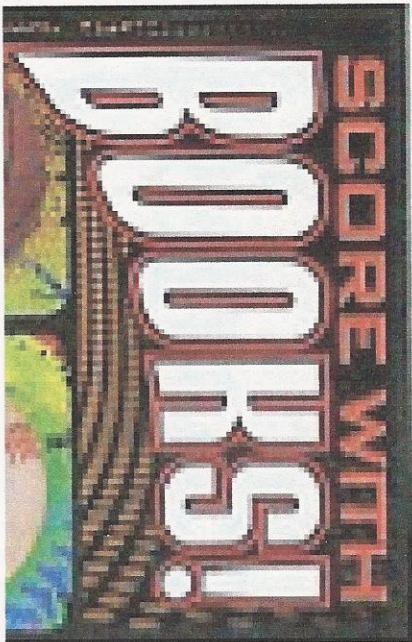

# 4-5 Reading Log

**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

- 1 Reading Log = 1 Game Period
- 4 Periods of Reading = 1 Game Finished
- 3 Finished Games = 1 Completed Scorecard

To complete a game period, fill out this reading log of 100 minutes and return it, signed by a parent or guardian, to the school library. After a log has been completed and turned in, start another. See how many games you can finish and scorecards you can complete.
